

TOWN OF LOYAL RECYCLING ORDINANCE

1.01 Title. Recycling Ordinance for Town of Loyal

1.02 Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to promote recycling and an effective recycling program.

1.03 Statutory Authority. This ordinance is adopted as authorized under Wisconsin Statute 287 and Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapter NR 542 to 549. Codes pertaining to recycling are available at the dnr.wi.gov website by searching “recycling law.”

1.04 Responsibility. Town of Loyal Board will hire a company that complies with Wisconsin State Statutes on recycling pickup. The company must provide requirements listed in the agreement of safe, reliable, affordable and environmentally friendly disposal of products. The residents have a necessary obligation to meet the standards requested in the business hired by the town board.

1.05 Information. A copy of the agreement with the recycling company will be on hand at the Town Hall at W3412 Chickadee Road.

1.06 Schedule. A recycling schedule will be mailed out with the yearly bill. All recycling bills will be mailed to the landowner and are to be paid at the beginning of the new recycling year. Any unpaid bills will go on taxes with all fees that apply, authorized under Wis. Stats. 287.09(3)(b).

1.07 Non-Recyclable. Items not listed in the agreement with the recycle/garbage company are the sole responsibility of the landowner.

1.08 Collections Sites. The DNR has information at <https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/ecycle> for the collection of non-recyclables and even more information on protecting the environment. A local option is First Choice Recycling in Spencer WI.
